Please note: Because we have been generously blessed with used clothing donations beyond our capacity to share them with those in need, **we are unable to accept used clothing at this time.** We recommend that you consider the following organizations for your used clothing donations: The River Food Pantry, St. Vincent de Paul, The Salvation Army, or Goodwill.

We gladly accept donations of other goods in new or like-new condition that benefit the moms, dads and babies we serve. Please be sure the items are clean when bringing them to us.

We also accept donations of non-perishable food for our residential program. Please check expiration dates before donating.

- New baby clothing: Size Newborn to 6 months
- Diapers: Newborn, Sizes 4-5
- Baby wipes
- Safety Items
- Diaper rash cream
- Men’s personal care items
- Women’s personal care items
- Diaper bags
- Boppi pillows
- New Infant toys
- Teething rings
- New shoes and socks
- Nursing tank tops that have detachable strap
- New car seats, strollers, other larger baby items

Other Needed Material Goods:

Small kitchen appliances in good working order/household items in new or like-new condition:

Home furnishings/household items in new or like-new condition. Only those listed:

- Lamps
- Bookcases

Electronics in good working order. Only those listed:

- Flat-screen TVs
- DVD players
- I-pods or mp3 players

New clothing

- Children's sizes newborn to 3T
- Maternity clothing – all sizes, especially size XXL
- Young women's clothing – current styles, all sizes, especially size XXL
- Scrubs – size XXL

Baby and children's items in new or like-new condition; must be clean

- Cribs – new in box only
- Car seats – new in box only
- Crib mattresses – new only
- Toddler beds
- Baby swings – in good working condition
- Strollers – clean, in good working condition, no tears or mold
- Stuffed animals – new only
- Baby care items in new or like-new condition – toys, baby bathtubs, books, crib sheets, hooded towels, etc.

Material Goods That We Cannot Accept

Stewardship is very important to us. Therefore there are certain items we cannot accept because they do not meet the immediate or near-term needs of our clients and/or residents. Or, they add cost to our operation and do not benefit our mission. Instead, we prefer to use every resource we have to help moms and babies. We regret we cannot accept the following items:

Baby/Infant Items listed below:

- Used clothing – children or adult
- Used infant sleep items: cribs, pack n plays, bassinets, etc.
- Used car seats or infant carriers
- Walkers
- Crib bedding sets (bumper pads and comforters)
- Beds
- Bedframes, mattresses, or box springs of any size or configuration other than new crib mattresses
- Waterbeds
- Hide-a-beds
- Used bedding

Computer equipment/electronics

Used clothing

Exercise equipment

Furniture

Large appliances

Items that are prohibitively large and heavy that are difficult to safely handle, or for which there is no current demand.

If your items have been stored in a garage, storage shed, or unfinished area of your home, please check them carefully before donating for mold, mildew, stains, tears, insects, rodent droppings, or other damage. We cannot accept such items.
