Fund Development

- Develop and execute a comprehensive and long-term financial development plan to further the mission of Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County.
- Cultivate relationships with donors, churches, staff, board members, and volunteers.
- Research, identify and write grant proposals, letters of intent, submit grant reports in collaboration with program directors.
- Oversee administration of donor database donor; prepare reports as needed.
- Lead prospective supporter tours to showcase programs.
- Develop and execute a major gifts program. Lead and manage staff in major gifts. Participate in the solicitation of gifts.
- Oversee special events and direct mail program.
- Evaluate ROI of fund development initiatives and pivot when necessary.
- Knowledge of all aspects of philanthropy including major gifts, direct mail, corporate and foundational giving, digital fundraising, special events, and grants.
- Experience with the Benevon Model is preferred but not required.

Marketing, Communications, and Administration.
